Registration: \$100.00 by December 8th
\$125.00 after December 8th

Once submitted, an entry fee will not be returned unless a substitute team is found.

Registration deadline – December 15, 2017 (the league may close registrations early when the allotted number of teams are registered). Do not wait –we have a limit on the number of teams that can enter

We turned away teams last year – register early!

Each team is guaranteed a minimum of three games. We will use the “shoot-out” format – 20 minute game.

Community Teams only.

Medals will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams.

Each participant (organization and individual) in this tournament must be covered by their own organization and/or individual insurance.

Admission to the games will be \$1.00 for adults and seniors for week night games
\$3.00 for adults, \$2.00 for seniors for Dec 30th games

All team members must have matching shirts with clearly visible numbers on the front and/or back of the jersey. No player can play on more than one team in the same division.

All teams will receive a game schedule and gym location on or before December 20th.

Each team playing will supply one individual to work the scoreboard/scoresheet

No player is permitted to play on more than one team in the same grade level. A player is permitted to play up one grade level in addition to their own grade.

2017 Mentor Holiday Basketball Tournament Game Rules:

Ten Foot Baskets and Youth Basketballs (28.5") will be used for all divisions.

Coaches are asked to report no later than one half hour before game time.

Games will be 20 minutes long. Each team will have one 30 second timeout per game.

The clock will run continuously until the last one minute of the game.

Teams may play any form of defense – zone, full court press, man to man etc. is permitted the full duration of the game. 3rd grade boys can press the last 4 minutes of the game.

When one team is ahead by 15 or more points, the team ahead is not allowed to press in the back court. The clock will also run continuously in the last minute of the game.

Foul shots will only take place during the last minute of the game. A player fouled in the act of shooting (shot made) will be awarded the appropriate points + 1 and the opponent takes the ball. A player fouled in the act of shooting (missed shot) will be awarded 1 point plus the ball out of bounds at the baseline. All fouls during last one minute of game will result in 2 free throws. Technical fouls will award the team 2 points plus the possession of the ball. Intentional fouls will award the team 2 points plus possession of the ball.

Tied score at the end of regulation – each team selects 2 team players to shoot one free throw. If still tied, each team selects one different team player to shoot a free throw until a winner is determined.

All referee's decisions are final and not subject to appeal. All decisions from the scorer's table and or by tournament officials are final. Verbal abuse of the referees from the stands will not be tolerated and will result in the automatic removal from the building.

Ejection from the game due to technical fouls or at the referee's discretion will result in said player, coach or spectator being asked to leave the premises. Any player, coach or spectator who is ejected will also be suspended from the next game.

Tiebreakers:

1.) head to head 2.) point differential +/- 15 points 3.) least points allowed
