GENERAL INFORMATION & ELIGIBILITY

- 2017 Tournament Dates:** Friday March 2nd thru Sunday March 4th
- Divisions:** Boys 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th Grade
Limit of 8 Teams per Grade—A & B teams welcome—will play together
Each Pool Winner & 2nd Place Pool Teams Advance to Semi-Finals
- Locations:** Brecksville-Broadview Hts High School & Middle School
St. Michael's Woodside Gym (Mill Road)
Brecksville Community Center
- Entry Fee:** \$200 per Team. Make checks payable to "CVYO". Complete roster must be turned in with check to hold entry spot.

- Registration Deadline:** January 30, 2018. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until full.
- Player Eligibility:** Players must play in their appropriate grade division or they may "play up" one grade. All players ages must be indicated on team roster form. Birth certificates should be available for inspection for all players during tournament play. All players must reside within the same city and/or the same school district. Players are only allowed to play on one team in the tournament.
- Tournament Rosters:** Must be filled out completely on the registration form and returned with entry fee. Team rosters are limited to 12 players and three coaches per team.
- Awards:** Individual and team trophies will be awarded to the champions and runner-ups in each grade division.
- Scheduling:** Please indicate any special scheduling requests along with your registration form. We will attempt to accommodate requests whenever possible.
- Spectator Admission:** Daily admission: \$3 Student; \$5 Adult or \$8 Weekend Pass. Kids age 5 & under free and Seniors \$3. Concessions will be available each day.
- Insurance:** Each organization/team must be covered by their own organization's and/or their own individual insurance policy(s).
- Uniforms:** Each team must supply their own jerseys with numbers on front and back.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- Format:** Pool Play Format—3 Game Guarantee
- Tie-Break Pool Play:** Head to Head, Point Differential (max 15/game), Points Allowed, Points Scored, Coin Flip; In the event of three team tie, head to head is not used. Top two teams are determined based on the remaining tie breakers above.
- Ejections:** Any player, coach or fan that is ejected from a game will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- Grace Period:** There will be a five minute grace period. If your team is not ready to play by that time, the game will be a forfeit and the score will be recorded as 15-0. Any team that has forfeited can not win a tiebreaker. Games may start up to 10 minutes before scheduled time if both head coaches are in agreement and both teams have had at least 5 minutes of warm-up time.
- Rules:** Ohio High School Athletic Association Rules apply, except where noted.
- Length of Game:** All games will consist of two 18 minute halves with a 4 minute halftime. The clock will stop on all whistles only during the last minute of 1st half and the last 2 minutes of the 2nd half. Clock will stop on shooting fouls and will re-start when ball is given to shooter for their second free throw. Overtime periods will be 3 minutes with clock stopping on all whistles. If the point differential is 15 points or greater in the 2nd half, the clock will run continuously (including free throws) until the point differential becomes less than 15 points. Teams are to be given a minimum of 5 minutes of warm-up prior to game start.
- Scoring:** The official score sheet will be kept at the scorer's table. The score book and scoreboard/clock will be kept by Tournament employees. Scorer's tabulation of fouls and game score is official and final.
- Time Outs:** Each team receives three full time outs per game and one full time out each overtime period. Unused timeouts do not carry over to overtime. Each timeout is one minute.
- Free Throws:** 1 and 1 on the 7th team foul each half. Double bonus on the 10th team foul each half. 3rd grade: 13 ft--shooter can jump over the 13ft free throw line but can not be the first to touch a missed free throw. 4th grade: 15ft--shooter can jump over the 15ft free throw line but can not be the first to touch a missed free throw.
- Defenses:** **3rd-5th Grade:** Man to Man defense only. Man to man pressing allowed in 2nd half & overtime only. When pressing, the defense can only have as many defenders in backcourt as the offense has and players must be guarding their man subject to "man to man help" defensive principles and switching. Traps are permissible but MUST be from a man to man defense. If lead is 15 points or more, no pressing is allowed.
- 6th Grade:** Any defense is permitted. Pressing allowed in 2nd half & overtime only. Subject to 15 point rule as stated above.

Interpretation of the rules and all decisions of the Tournament Director are final.
